7. Our fleet is awarded at least one trophy for each of the three "series" races. To qualify, you must sail at least 5 races in the spring series, 5 races in the commodore series and 8 races in the premier series.
8. My wife and I want to continue the after race picnics like we had last year. Bring a dish and your favorite beverage and join us on the hill after racing. Stay as long or as short as you wish. We won't be doing it this coming Sunday (29th) or the next, but will start with the PARTY on the 20th.
